✔ **Buddy Program**

We offer the opportunity for the newly diagnosed, their families and friends to speak to others who have “been there.” A Buddy listens, offers support, and shares their story and personal perspective of the disease with you. They are there to provide information on coping with side effects, treatment options, life after a colostomy, or dealing with the many emotional issues that come with this illness, from both a patient and caregiver’s perspective. You can also volunteer to be a Buddy.

✔ **“Conversations About Colorectal Cancer” Regional Seminars**

We host seminars for newly diagnosed, advanced disease patients, long-term survivors, caregivers and friends, nurses and other healthcare professionals. Each seminar includes the most up-to-date colorectal cancer treatment information from leading colorectal cancer healthcare professionals and forums for peer-to-peer support.
